Dr. Lam Akol is a prominent politician in South Sudan.

"The Scriptures teach us how Jesus Christ loved children. He used to tell his disciples: let the children come to me. You the children are our responsibility because you are the future of this country; you are the ones who will inherit this country from the current crop of people. After 20 years you may not see us around. So, you are the ones who will continue carrying out what we have set ourselves to achieve.

I thank the Nile Orphanage Care for having listened to your cry; the cry I have just heard from your singing, and gave their time selflessly to establish this institution which we hope will grow into something that our people will be proud about.

I can't also end without thanking the people who stood with us; stood with you. Those people are not related to you, none of them has relatives among you, none of them has relatives even in the whole South Sudan. But they were moved by humanity, humanity knows no bounds, and they selflessly contributed financially and otherwise to see that this institution is built to take care of you until you reach the age when you are able to take care of yourself and of others too.

My pledge to you is simple: I will support you morally all the time and financially when I can. And I will advocate for your case and your cause in whatever forum I am part of."
